

WAS committed to the Jail of Baltimore City and County on the 4th day of September, 1838, by James L. Maguire, Esq. a Justice of the Peace, in and for the City of Baltimore, a negro man, as a runaway, named **EMORY DAVIS**; who says he belongs to Ann Nevitt, who lives in Broad Creek Neck, Talbot County, Md. His age is about 25 years; 6 feet in height, and is lame in the left hip; dark complexion. Had on when committed, a pair of cassinet pants, red gingham shirt, straw hat, an old valencia vest, and a new pair of shoes.

The owner, if any, of the above described negro man, is requested to come forward, prove property, pay charges and take him away, otherwise he will be discharged according to law.
