

# RUNAWAYS.

Run away on Saturday night, the 24th of November, from the farm belonging to Capt. John Hutchinson, dec'd, a negro man, named Charles, about 35 years old, rather dark and likely, quick spoken and well made; about 5 feet 9 or 10 inches high.—clothes not recollected.—Also a negro woman, belonging to Mrs. Nancy Hutchinson, about 34 or 5 years old, of a chesnut color, spare and delicate.—It is supposed that they have gone away together. A reward of \$200 will be given for the man and \$60 for the woman if taken out of the State, or \$100 for the man and \$30 for the woman if taken within the State. The above reward will be paid on the delivery of said negroes to me, near New Market, Dorchester county, Md, or if secured in gaol, so that I get them again.
