

WAS COMMITTED to the Jail of Baltimore City and County on the 7th day of May, 1840, by John Wright, Esq. a Justice of the Peace, in and for the city of Baltimore, a negro man, as a runaway, named Francis Carroll, who says he belongs to Henrietta Haywood, Easton, E. S. Md. He is of dark complexion, aged between 30 and 40 years, and 5 ft. 5½ inches in height. Had on when committed a blue cloth roundabout jacket, check shirt, Kersey pantaloons, old black fur hat and coarse shoes. Has a scar on his right temple and one other scar over the right eye.

The owner, if any, of the above described negro man is requested to come forward, prove property, pay charges, and take him away, otherwise he will be discharged according to law. D. HERRING, Warden
