

WAS COMMITTED to the Jail of Baltimore City and County, on the 30th day of August, 1841, by A. H. Pennington, Esq a Justice of the Peace in and for the City of Baltimore, a negro man, as a runaway, named JOSHUA RAYFIELD, who says he belongs to Harrison Rayfield, of or living near Franktown, Northampton County, Virginia. He is 5 feet 7 $\frac{1}{2}$ inches high, firm built, not stout, and about 25 years of age, with good features. Had on when committed, a tarpaulin hat, canvass trowsers, coarse twilled cotton shirt and pumps.

The owner, if any, of the above described negro man, is requested to come forward, prove property, pay charges, and take him away, otherwise he will be discharged according to law.
