

WAS COMMITTED to the Jail of Baltimore City and County, on the 10th April, 1842, by Wm. B. Jones, Esq. a Justice of the peace in and for the city of Baltimore, as a runaway, a negro woman, who called herself MARY WILSON when committed but has since stated that her name is ELIZA ANN JONES, and that she belongs to Dr. Thompson, of Cambridge, Md. She is about 30 years of age, 5 feet 5 inches high, rather good looking, and has a scar on her face, near the left nostril. Had on when committed, a blue calico frock and blue stockings, with fine shoes.

The owner if any of the above described negro woman is requested to come forward, prove property, pay charges and take her away, otherwise she will be discharged according to law.
