

**W**AS committed to the Jail of Baltimore City and County, on the 25<sup>th</sup> of June, 1842, by Wm. B. Jones, Esq. a Justice of the Peace in and for Baltimore city, as a runaway, a Negro Boy, who calls himself John Wesley Moore. He is about 11 or 12 years of age and 4 feet 2 inches high. Had on when committed an old torn silk hat, muslin shirt and tow linen pantaloons. He says that he has been used to staying on board of a vessel on the Eastern Shore, and that his master's name is Elijah Johnson. The owner, if any, of the above described negro boy, is requested to come forward, prove property, pay charges and take him away, otherwise he will be discharged according to law.
