Schæffer, Esq., a Justice of the Peace, in and for the city of Baltimore, as a runaway, a Negro Boy, who calls himself GEORGE WASHINGTON. He is about 20 years of age, 5 feet 6 inches high, quite dark, good looking, round form, has a large scar from a burn on the right shoulder, and states that he formerly belonged to Capt. Hazard, of Anne Arundel county. Had on when committed a cotton flannel shirt and white pantaloons. The owner, if any, of the above described negro boy, is requested to come for ward, prove property, pay charges and take him away, otherwise he will be discharged according to law.
