Robinson, of Somerset county, but is now free by manumission, as the records of said county will show; he further states that he last lived in Baltimore, and worked for Wm. & George Gardiners, Fell's Point;—he is of a light complexion, about 5 feet 5½ inches high, and also says he is about 35 years of age—has a scar on the left cheek, and one on the back of the right hand;—had on when committed, blue cassinett pantaloons, blue muslin shirt, black wool hat, also had in his possession a pair of white cotton pantaloons.

The owner of the said negro is hereby warned to come forward and prove property, or else he will be discharged according to law.
