

## NOTICE.

**W**AS COMMITTED to the Jail of Prince George's county, Maryland, on the 12th of April, 1851, as a runaway, a negro man calling himself WM. CARTER *alias* JOHN THOMAS, who says he belongs to Wm. Henry Thomas near Chaptico, St. Mary's county, Md. He is of the ordinary height, quite black, and appears to be about 25 or 30 years old. He had in his possession a "pass," signed George Gipson, certifying that he is free. The owner of the above negro is requested to come and prove him, pay charges, and take him away; he will otherwise be dealt with according to law.
