

# \$150 REWARD.

**T**HE above reward will be given for the apprehension and delivery to me of two negro men who escaped from the Jail of Prince George's county on the 20th of Aug. 1851 :



**HENRY COMPTON** is a copper color—5 feet 7 or 8 inches high, well formed, about 35 years old. No marks recollected. He was in custody as the property of the late Dr. Greenfield. He has a wife belonging to Dr. Lewis Mackall. He may be lurking at his farm near Nottingham; or he may be in Georgetown, D. C., where he was apprehended some time since.



**WILLIAM CARTER** is about 35 years of age, quite black, about 5 feet 6 or 7 inches high, and has lost the tips of two of the fingers of his right hand. He was committed as the property of George A. Digges, Esq., who purchased him from William H. Thomas, near Chaptico, St. Mary's county. He is supposed to be lurking in that neighborhood.

Seventy five dollars will be given for the apprehension and delivery to me, or securing in jail of either of these men.
