



RUNAWAY.—Was committed to the jail of Talbot county, as a runaway, on the 18th inst., by William B. Wheeler, Esq., J. P., a negro boy calling himself DENNIS, about 17 or 18 years of age.

He is a bright mulatto, with freckled face, and about five feet high. He says he is an apprentice to Capt. Isaac S. Sanner, in Baltimore, and was hired for the present year to Mrs. Kitty Denny, of this county, and that he ran away from her. He was taken up by Capt. Gibson, at Black Walnut Point, Tilghman's Island, where he came ashore in a small canoe, having with him an extra coat and a musket, and was enquiring the way to Swann Point.

The owner of said mulatto, if any, is requested to come forward, prove property, pay charges, and take him away, otherwise he will be discharged according to law.
