

DESCRIPTION OF A PART OF THE REMINGTON ARMS CO. LANDS,
SIXTH DISTRICT, KENT COUNTY, MD.


Beginning for the same at a concrete monument on the southwest side of Md. Rte. 21 (25' from the centerline), said point being the easternmost corner of the herein described lands and the northernmost corner of the lands of John R. Dierker, Jr.; and running, thence, by and with said Dierker lands S 53 11 W - 150.00' to a concrete monument and a new division line between the herein described lands and other lands of Remington Arms Co.; thence, by and with said new division line N 36 49 W - 100.00' to a concrete monument and N 53 11 E - 150.00' to a concrete monument and the southwest side of Md. Rte. 21; thence, by and with the southwest side of said road S 36 49 E - 100.00' to the place of beginning. Containing in all 15,000 square feet of land, more or less.




