


Description of a Right-of-Way Through the Eastern  
Business Farms, Inc. Lands, Chestertown, Kent County,  
Maryland

Beginning for the same at a concrete monument on the northeast side of High Street Extended (708wide), said monument <sup>marks</sup> marking the division line between the lands of \_\_\_\_\_ and the Eastern Business Farms, Inc. lands, of which the herein described lands are a part; and running, thence, by and with the \_\_\_\_\_ lands N 59° 57' 30" E - 157.93' to a concrete monument and a new division line between the herein described lands and other lands of Eastern Business Farms, Inc.; thence, by and with said new division line N 49° 37' 20" E - 544.28' to the lands recently conveyed to Washington College; thence, by and with said Washington College lands S 26° 14' 20" E - 47.31' to the lands of the Chestertown Cemetery; thence, by and with said cemetery lands and the lands of James Lee S 49° 37' 20" W - 689.15' to a concrete monument, and continuing on the same course S 49° 37' 20" W - 10.00' to the side of the aforementioned High Street Extended; thence, by and with the northeast side of said High Street Extended N 31° 53' 20" W - 75.03' to the place of beginning. Containing in all 0.791 acres of land, more or less.
