

DESCRIPTION OF A PART OF THE FRANK KING LANDS,
FIRST DISTRICT, QUEEN ANNES COUNTY, MD.

Beginning for the same at a point in the centerline of the county road leading from Md. Rte. 300 towards Schenk Corner, said point being the northernmost corner of the herein described lands; and running, thence, by and with a new division line between the herein described lands and other lands of Frank King the nine following courses and distances: (1) S 39 30 E - 29.48' to an iron pipe, (2) S 39 30 E - 654.69' to an iron pipe, (3) N 45 04 E - 67.10' to an iron pipe, (4) S 44 56 E - 180.00' to an iron pipe, (5) S 45 04 W - 300.00' to an iron pipe, (6) N 44 56 W - 180.00' to an iron pipe, (7) N 45 04 E - 182.68' to an iron pipe, (8) N 39 30 W - 628.21' to an iron pipe, and (9) N 39 30 W - 29.48' to the centerline of the aforementioned county road; thence, by and with the centerline of said road N 18 30 E - 58.96' to the place of beginning. Containing in all 2.010 acres of land, more or less.

FIRST DISTRICT, QUEEN ANNES COUNTY, MD.


Beginning for the same at a point in the centerline of the Busicks Church - Andersons Corner County Road, said point being the northernmost corner of the herein described lands and the westernmost corner of the lands of Bessie L. Meeks; and running, thence, by and with said Meeks lands the four following courses and distances: (1) S 52 35 50 E 43.41' to a concrete monument, (2) S 52 35 50 E - 770.80' to a concrete monument, (3) S 33 08 W - 115.59' to a concrete monument, and (4) S 57 56 50 E - 1705.98' to a steel fence post and the lands of others; thence, by and with the lands of others S 34 01 30 W - 572.33' to a new division line between the herein described lands and other lands of King; thence, by and with said new division line N 49 45 50 W 2418.33' to the intersection of the centerlines of the aforementioned County Road and a culvert under said road; thence, by and with the centerline of said road N 18 29 50 E - 431.28' to the place of beginning. Containing in all 25.000 acres of land, more or less.








PLAT OF THE DIVISION OF THE
