

DESCRIPTION OF THE GEORGIA H. WILSON LANDS,
CENTREVILLE, QUEEN ANNES COUNTY, MD.


Beginning for the same at a point on the back of the curb on the southeast side of Liberty Street, said point being the northernmost corner of the lands of the Corsica Corporation (formerly P.H. Thompson lands) and the westernmost corner of the herein described lands; and running, thence, by and with Liberty St. along the back of the curb N 53 03 40 E - 54.08 to the lands of Bethel M.E. Church; thence, by and with said church lands S 38 39 40 E - 4.24 to a fence post and S 38 39 40 E - 75.78 to a fence post and other lands of The Corsica Corporation (formerly a part of the herein described lands); thence, by and with said Corsica Corporation lands S 40 24 10 E - 5.29 to an iron pipe and ~~S 48 59 50 W - 37.68~~ to an iron pipe and the aforementioned Corsica Corporation lands acquired from P.H. Thompson; thence, by and with said former Thompson lands N 49 16 10 W - 87.01 to a concrete monument and N 49 16 10 W - 3.00 to the place of beginning. Containing in all 3,977 square feet of land, more or less.

Being all of the remaining lands described in a deed from _____ Benton to _____ Wilson, dated _____, and recorded in the Land Record Books of Queen Annes County, liber BHT 3, folio 28.
