

DESCRIPTION OF THE FLORENCE E. TARR LANDS, GRASONVILLE,  
FIFTH DISTRICT, QUEEN ANNES COUNTY, MD.

Beginning for the same at an iron pipe on the west side of Station Lane (30' wide), said point being the northeast corner of the herein described lands and the southeast corner of the lands of Elmer G. Crouse; and running, thence, by and with the west side of said road S 11 07 20 W - 55.27', along a curve the chord of which is S 0 40 50 E - 63.05', and S 10 31 30 E - 107.51' to a "P.K." nail on the north side of the concrete walk at the north side of Md. Rte. 18; thence, by and with the north side of Md. Rte. 18 along a slight curve N 81 58 10 W - 133.70' to an iron pipe on the north side of the walk and the lands of John G. Minch; thence, by and with said Minch lands N 09 26 40 E - 196.33' to a stone and the lands now or formerly of Amos South; thence, by and with said South lands N 72 00 30 E - 86.20.72' to an iron pipe and the lands of Elmer G. Crouse; thence, by and with said Crouse lands S 78 59 E - 86.20' to the place of beginning. Containing in all 0.515 acres of land, more or less
