He signed his Qualification papers Nov 26-1768 (Pennsylvania Record) After signing his Qualification paper he never again used the name Frederick. Wilhelm Hoffmann aged 31 married Susanna Weinbach aged 29, June 4-1771 at St Michaels & Zion Luther Church Philadelphia Pa. Witnesses, Samuel Hildecker & Wm Keamerer. (Record Penna. Archives End Swries, Vol. 9 Page 356 Edition 1890) After marriage Wilhelm Hoffmann changed the Wilhelm to William as was generally done by Germans who were establishing permanent homes in America.
