The One World Ensemble — four of America's finest voices — combine their artistic and cultural resources into a musical symbol of world harmony. Organized by Dick Campbell to meet the many requests of enlightened organizations seeking novel entertainment, the Ensemble, with a Jewish music director, is composed of:

1. HIDEKO YOSHINO — Japanese American soprano was born in Alameda, California and is a former student of the University of California. During World War II she was attached to the Rocky Mountain USO as a volunteer artist, and later made a coast to coast good will recital tour under auspices of the American Citizens League.

2. ELIZABETH DUNNING — Scotch-Irish contralto is the possessor of a rare voice of pure contralto quality, and is an excellent musician. She has sung under the baton of Toscanini, Rodzinski and Beecham in radio, concert and opera, and is the leading solist at Temple Emanu-El, Fifth Avenue, New York. Personable and charming, she is a native of Plainfield, N. J.

3. NAPOLEON REED — Negro tenor is an artist with a background in concert, radio, opera and musical comedy from coast to coast. He sang the leadinfg role in "Aida" with The National Negro Opera Company in New York, Chicago, Pittsburgh and Washington and was also the tenor star in Carmen Jones.

4. BURTON CORNWALL — English-American basso-cantante, has sung nearly all the operatic roles written for the basso in French, German, Italian and English. He is one of the most popular oratorio singers in New York and his full bodied basso has given support to hundreds of radio performances.

Although they are glad for an opportunity to "show off" a practical example of a democratic principal in action, the paramount objective of the artists is to render the finest musical program possible through their extraordinary and diversified talent.

# THE EXPERIMENTAL DANCE GROUP OF THE KATHERINE DUNHAM SCHOOL OF CULTURAL ARTS

The Experimental Group was formed by Miss Dunham to have a flexible, small group of dancers who could afford to take the timeto experiment with movement patterns and various authentic fanciful ballet ideas which she could not do with her largest group. Henri Augustine, native of Haiti and head of the Percussion Department in the New York School, expertly provides the incessant accompaniment on Haitian, Cuban, or Brazilian drums according to the dance origin.

This group has delighted many audiences including Columbia University, New York University, University of Pennsylvania, and Howard University, The Delve Woman's Club, at the Mosque, Richmond, Virginia, and numerous organizations — philanthropic, ethnic and cultural, as well as the new field of television entertainment.

Superbly trained, exotic and dynamic in authentic colorful costuming, these dancers perform with such amazing verve, understanding, and sympathy for their subject that the emotional impact is delightful as well as informative.

### PROGRAM

The Caribbean Islands offer wonderful source material for the investigators seeking authentic information concerning the dances and rituals of the peoples brought to the Western Hemisphere as slaves. Here in practically inaccessible and untouched interior places, dances and rituals are preserved intact.

#### I. CARNIVAL

All of the Caribbean Islands hold Carnivals during Lent. Bands of people, led by a 'King' of 'best dancer', travel from town to town visiting friends and seeing the countryside. Two such bands meet; the 'kings' complete, and the crowd decides the winner.

### II. CONGO PAILLETTE

Probably has its origin in fertility rites. Has now lost its significance and is danced chiefly for pleasure.

#### CHICA

Really a working bee known in Haiti as a 'Combite', where, with songs and dances, crops are harvested, houses built, etc.

#### III. MOUNDONGO

A Haitian chant to the God Moundongo,, who was supposed to have eaten human flesh, is now used as the basis for a festive play dance.

#### IV. MAZOUK

West Indian form of the Pollsh 'Mazurka'. Originally danced in mim'ory of their European masters, The Mazouk is now a graceful, rhythmic dance of the Martinique people, still containing faint traces of its former satire,

### DOROTHY MAYNOR, Soprano

Dorothy Maynor's childhood was spent in the home of a Methodist vicarage in Nortolk where she absorbed the haunting music of Negro spirituals even before she could talk. Together with her brother and sister, Dorothy helped her father and his struggling parish by singing in the church choir. At fourteen, she entered Hampton Institute to prepare for a career in home economics. Her musical talent received instant recognition when, as a member of the Hampton Choir, she was one of  $\epsilon$  carefully selected group to tour the United States and Europe.

Throughout her subsequent school years her musical development was greatly aided by friends who recognized her genius and were instrumental in shaping her career. Dr. Nathaniel Dett persuaded Miss Maynor to change her major to music. John Finly Williamson offered her a scholarship at the Westminister Choir School at Princeton, and Miss Harriet Curtis was the friend who provided funds for Dorothy Maynor to study voice in New York.

The gifted young singer was greatly encouraged by these expressions of faith and friendship and devoted the next three years to intensive studies of language, concert and opera singing with her voice teacher. To supplement her meager income, she took a job as conductor of the choir of the Nazarene Congregational Church in Brooklyn.

Since her sensational "discovery" by Serge Koussevitzky at the Berkshire Musical Festival in 1939, Miss Maynor has streaked to the top rank of singing stars in America's musical horizon. Following her debut performance at the Town Hall in New York, came subsequent engagements with the New York Philharmonic, Chicago, Philadelphia, and Cleveland orchestras. Miss Maynor made many transcontinental tours, and during the war, her voice was heard in camps and hospitals by men and women in the armed services. She has also been heard by vast audiences throughout the country here and abroad through radio broadcasts, and many of her songs are permanently preserved in record libraries. Miss Maynor has recently appeared at the Teatio Auditorium in Havana, Cuba.

A rare phenomenon among singers, this artist has some astounding musical accomplishments — she can play the oboe, the piano, the French horn, orchestrate a song, and transpose accompaniment at sight. She is often affectionately referred to as a "musician's musician."
