3. In case of "suspension" and "expulsion," the offence of which the brother was found guilty must be stated. It is not sufficient to say "unbecoming" or "unworthy conduct."
4. Suspended, expelled or resigned members are not to be included as members until reinstated.
5. Each Division, County and State should keep a copy or duplicate of Report.
