Gary Green of Darnestown, patriarch of the Green family and friend of public education, is being remembered 150 years following his birth. Born in slavery, he achieved his freedom while still a young man. He was a talented and enterprising carpenter/builder who with his sons constructed a number of the late 19th houses and buildings in the Montgomery County black community. He married Matilda Mason, acquired property near the village of Darnestown and established a homestead there. The Greens had four daughters, three of whom married into the local Ricks family; and eight sons. Three sons: William Edward, Ernest J. and John Wesley married and established families in Washington, D. C. Alonzo moved to New York City and never married; Eugene settled in Philadelphia and established a family there. Daughters Jimmy, Jane, Emma and Ida (married a Waters) remained in the Darnestown/Quince Orchard area as did sons Vernon, Robert and Alexander many of whose descendants have remained in Montgomery County.

The Greens established a Methodist tradition for the family and were among the founders of the Pleasant View Methodist Episcopal Church at Quince Orchard.

GARY GREEN, A FRIEND OF PUBLIC EDUCATION

The Green children were born several years before, during and following the Civil War. Family tradition holds that the Union soldiers camped nearby and that the local women and children were cautioned to be wary of the foraging men in blue. Additionally, Maryland as a border state and officially a Union state, was next door neighbor to the Confederate State of Virginia. And, until slavery was officially abolished in the nation, there was always the threat that a free black could be kidnapped and 'sold South' into slavery. At best, it was an uncertain and desperate time for many and especially a young colored family with infant and small children on the edge of the Confederacy.

Public education for blacks in Montgomery County did not begin until 1872. However, prior to that time Gary Green, James Ricks and Carlton Mose had formed an association to provide a school for the black children of the Quince Orchard/Darnestown area.

Montgomery County Land Records reveal that Gary Green et al on September 18, 1868 acquired a one acre lot in trust for the purpose of "erecting or allowing to be erected thereon a schoolhouse for the use, benefit and education of the colored people of Montgomery County forever."

Gary Green and his neighbors apparently constructed a schoolhouse on the property and hired a teacher on their own. We find that during March 1874, Gary Green, appeared before the Montgomery County Board of Commissioners to request funds for the payment of the teacher at the Quince Orchard Colored School. The Board agreed to pay the teacher's salary provided the lot and schoolhouse were conveyed to the County Board of Commissioners.

The record reveals further that on April 14, 1874, Gary Green, James Ricks and Carlton Mason conveyed the house and lot to the County commissioners for the sum of \$5.00 to be used "exclusively for the education of the colored youth of the neighborhood."

In 1892, the school is described as being a 22' x 28' wooden structure insured for \$300 and located near the Pleasant View Church. The Rev. Ernest Green, a son of the Greens, who attended the school recalled it as "a little red schoolhouse."
