

Elisabeth Gordon Chandler, sculptor of statue of Queen Anne (1665-1714), to be unveiled by Her Royal Highness Princess Anne, June 18, 1977 at the Queen Anne's County Court House in Centreville, Maryland.

Mrs. Chandler, of Old Lyme, Connecticut, is best known for her portraits in bronze. She did a bust of James F. Forrestall for the air craft carrier that bears his name, a portrait bust of Chief Justice Harlan Fiske Stone for the Law School at Columbia University, and a bust of Adlai Stevenson for the Woodrow Wilson School at Princeton University.

Mrs. Chandler, an Associate of the National Academy of Design, was commissioned for the Queen Anne statue by Wye Institute of Queenstown, Maryland. The statue is a gift to Queen Anne's County, by the Institute.
