Dear Sir

Col. Banisters Jan 6. 1781.

Col. ~~Smith~~ ^{Smith} has Instructions of the Baron de ~~Sturton~~
to carry into Execution which he will communicate to
you for the accomplishment of which he will require
about Twenty Horsemen properly officered - These I would
recommend to be furnished immediately out of the Volunteers
and other Corps which may be ~~sent~~ at hand and whom
you may judge best adapted to that particular Duty
as I don't propose taking Command here I shall leave
it to your Judgment and discretion to carry the
Barons orders into Execution in that manner you
may judge most expedient and conducive to the Service
and shall be happy in consulting and coinciding in
Sentiment with you and him in every Measure to
promote the public Service Good at this alarming
Crisis tho' I do not wish to interfere in the Command
