Levin Handy to William Smallwood

27 April 1782

Summary: Handy has petitioned the General Assembly to receive his back-pay, and would like Smallwood's assistance securing the money he is owed.

April 27th 1782.

Dear General,

I have lately prepared a Petition to the Honorable Assembly of Maryland, in order to have the depreciation of my pay made up, and in consequence must beg you will use your Interest in my favor to forward the same; as I make no doubt but you are fully acquainted with the Circumstances attending my Resignation.
