Certificate ^{the next time I have the pleasure of seeing you,} Mr. Carlton who does bus-
iness in the Minister's at war Office
acknowledges the justice of my acc.
and says he will give me a ~~certificate~~
warrant for the money on getting yours
or Gen. Galt's certificate —

I can't ^{not} be positive as to the time of the
arrangement's taking place nor do I
much expect any pay after that time
If you'll send me a certificate by the
first opportunity if much Obedient
