WESTERN SHORE TREASURY,
Annapolis, February 4th, 1830.

To the Honorable the
General Assembly of Maryland.

In obedience to an order of the last House of Delegates, passed 6th of March, 1829. "That the Treasurer of the Western Shore, be instructed to require of the President and Directors of the Union Bank of Maryland, a statement of the amount of capital stock of the said Bank, and of the debts due to and from the same, of the monies deposited therein, of the notes in circulation, of the cash in hand, and of the profits made; and that it shall be the duty of the said Treasurer especially, to request of the said President and Directors, information as to the nature and validity of the fund, amounting to the sum of \$511 762 45, held by the said Bank to meet losses, with a view to the ascertainment of the value of the State's right to reserved shares in the said Bank, and that the said Treasurer do report thereon to the Legislature at the commencement of its next session."
