FROM THE

GOVERNOR OF MARYLAND,

TO THE

GOVERNORS OF VIRGINIA AND DELAWARE.

COUNCIL CHAMBER,  
ANNAPOLIS, June , 1832.

SIR:—I transmit to your Excellency, the accompanying report and resolutions of the General Assembly of this State, in compliance with the request contained therein.

The first movement of this State, upon the subject matter of the report and resolutions, was an application to the General Government, to have the contemplated survey made by the officers and authority of the United States; and we have not entirely relinquished the hope, that this may yet be done.

No appointment of Commissioner or Engineer, as provided for by the resolution, has yet been made; but probably will be at the next session of the Council, unless, in the mean time, the Government of the United States shall have provided for making the said survey.
