Resolved, That our Senators in Congress be instructed to use all and our Representatives be requested to use all control of the req tional means in their power, to procure a peaceable addr. ment of the existing controversy between the State South Carolina and the General Government, and to grant the General Government, and the General Government of General Government, and the General Government of duce a reconciliation between the contending parties.

Resolved further, That a copy of these resolutions respectfully communicated by his Excellency the Govern of this State, to the President of the United States, the Governors of the several States, and to our Senators 2:

Representatives in Congress.
