

## Nat. 4-H Club Body Named

Maryland representatives are named for the National 4-H Club Camp, atherine Uebel, of Baltimore county, Jessie Guard and William Powell of Allegany county, and George Lechlinder, Montgomery county, have been designated as the four delegates who will represent the State of Maryland at the thirteenth annual National 4-H Club Camp, which is scheduled to be held in Washington from June 15 to 21. The delegates have been in club work from three to seven years each. Two are 18 years of age, one is 20 and the other 21.

Miss Uebel has carried projects in clothing, foods and nutrition, flower gardening, health, handicrafts and community activities. She has been active in local, county and State 4-H Club activities and, in addition to organizing a girls' club, has held the offices of president, secretary and treasurer. She has also been outstanding in school and church activities and has been looked upon as a decided leader.

Miss Guard has taken an active part in the Garrett County Older Youth Club. She has been a member for three years and was elected president last year. She is president of the Garrett County 4-H Club Council, was a delegate to the Rural Women's Short Course last year, has attended the annual achievement day of the Homemakers Clubs and was a delegate to the State 4-H Club Council meeting.

William Powell has been in club work for seven years and has completed projects in poultry, gardening and dairy. He has been local leader of the Williams Road Boys 4-H Club for four years and secretary of the Allegany County Boys' club federation. He has served as delegate from Allegany county to several State meetings, 4-H Club Week at College Park, and the meeting of the State 4-H Club Council.

George Lechlinder has also been in club work seven years. He has been president of the Rockville 4-H Club and an active member of the Senior 4-H Club Council for Montgomery county. His projects for this year have included one pen of Western lambs, two baby beef calves, a small herd of purebred Hampshire swine, and a flock of chickens.

### 4-H CLUB ENROLLMENT

The total enrollment in 4-H Club work in Maryland in 1938 was 4,727 boys and 6,195 girls, or a total of 10,922, the largest enrollment in the history of club work in this state, according to E. G. Jenkins, State Club Agent.

## DELEGATES TO POULTRY CONGRESS PLAN TO VISIT UNIVERSITY OF MD.

A large number of official delegates from foreign countries attending the Seventh World's Poultry Congress will visit the University of Maryland on a pre-Congress tour which is scheduled for July 26, it is announced by Dr. Morley A. Jull, head of the Poultry Department of the University. He says that already forty countries have accepted the invitation to participate in the Congress, which is to be held in Cleveland from July 28 to August 7, and it is expected that most of the delegates will stop at the University on their way West.

According to present plans, the delegates will assemble at College Park on the morning of July 26 for the opening exercises and dedication of the new Poultry Building which is now in process of construction. This building, which is being erected just east of the present horticulture building and north of the chemistry building, will conform in architecture to the other new buildings which have been built in recent years at College Park, and will house the research laboratories, lecture rooms and offices of the department of poultry.

Following the dedication the delegates will be conducted on a tour of the new poultry plant where they will see the various types of work carried on by the University in serving the poultry industry of the State.

Plans are being made by the Maryland State Poultry Council to have a large delegation on hand for the occasion.


