

**TWO HELD IN DEATH OF COUNTY NEGRO**

Two white men are charged with manslaughter as the result of the death of Clifton Jenifer on Saturday, July 4th, by drowning.

According to information, Claude Bennett, age 22 years, of Secretary, Md., and John McCoughan, age 27, of Seaford, Del., were crabbing on the Taylor's Island Bridge. It is alleged that they had been on the island most of the day crabbing and bathing, and at one time threw one of their own party into the water. It is reported that they then grabbed the Negro, who also was crabbing on the bridge, and threw him into the water. He did not come up, and the men notified the authorities.

The two men were brought to jail and a charge of manslaughter placed against them. Their bail was fixed at \$1,000 and Bennett was released last Sunday night, and McCoughan Monday afternoon. Their hearing was held Wednesday afternoon at two o'clock before Trial Magistrate William T. Nabb.

State Police and county authorities grappled for the Negro's body for about an hour and a half before it was recovered. The restitutor was used for about 40 minutes, but without success. Dr. Joseph K. Shriver, deputy medical examiner, issued a verdict of drowning. The other members in the party with Bennett and McCoughan were Christopher White and John H. Bennett of Seaford, William Bennett, son of John H. Bennett, and Christopher White, Jr., age 11, son of Christopher White.


