Tracibe to further Enadled, That the Money ariling by Inch iale, thall be by the respective Sheriffs paid unto the Treasuers of the respective Shores of this Province, whose Receipt, or the same, under Hand and Seal, well Evidenced, shall be a good Discharge to such Sheriff or Sheriffs And the said Treasurers shall, and they are hereby obliged and directed to, pay the said Money from Time to Time, to the Visitors of the said Two Schools, or their Order, in equal Proportions.

And whereas, by an Act entituled, A Petitionary Act for

Free Schools, made at a Seffion of Affembly held at the Port of Annapolis, the first Day of July in the — Year of the Reign of King William the Third, of glorious Memory, in the Year of our Lord God, One Thousand Six Hundred Ninety and Nine, a School is appointed at Anne-Arundel Town, now the City of Annapolis, called King William's School, whereby Trustees were appointed, with a Power of Succession, and incorporated into a Body Politic, capable of having, receiving, and holding Estates, to the uses of the said School, and perpetuated by the Name of Resors, Governors and Visitors of King William's School, reference to the same Act had, may appear, and inasmuch as the said School so established, hath some Foundation by the Gift of the Honourable BENEDICT LEONARD CALVERT, Esq; Deceased, and Others, though not sufficient to answer the End proposed, This General Assembly theretore, the better to establish and perpetuate the same, pray that it may be Enacted.

And be it naded, That the faid King William's School in the City of Annapolis, shall be the School intended, construed. and meant to be by this Act est blished on the Western Shore of this Province, and that his Excellency SAMUEL OOLE, Esquire, the present Rector, Governors, and Visitors of the same School, and their Successors, shall, and are hereby Declared and Enacted to be the Rector, Governors and Visitora of the faid School, to the Uies, Purpoles and Intents of this Act, and are hereby made capable to receive all Monies by this Act, given and granted for erecting and supporting one good School on the Western Shore of this Province, and that fuch Succession of Rector, Governors and Visitors, shall be perpetuated as is directed by the said last recited Act.

And for the better Establishment, and Conducting the faid

on the Eastern Shore of this Province, Be it Enalled, That the Lands and Building now belonging to the County School of -- County, shall not be fold, but kept and preferved for the School intended by this Ad; and that - - shall and are hereby Declared and Enacted to be Governors and Visions of the faid --- School in -- aforefaid. - shall for the Space and Term of Twelve Months and that next after the end of this Seffion of Assembly, be and is hereby declared, Rector of the same school; and that from and after the Time aforelaid, he the faid ---, and the Governors and Visitors aforelaid, or the major part of them, and their Succesfors, shall, and they are Declared and Enacted to be Incorporated into a Body Politic, by the Name of the Rector, Governors, and Vifitors of School in with full Power to plead and be impleaded, to fue and be fued, to defend and be defended, to answer and be answered, in all and every Cause, Complaint and Action, Real, Personal or Mixt, of whatsoever. nature it, shall be, in whatfoever Courts and Places of Judicature. within the Kingdom of Great Britain, or the Dominions)thereunto belonging, and have Power to receive a Grant, Gift, Allignment or Bequest, of any Lands, Tenements, or Heredie laments, Rents, Services, Annuities, Pensions, Inheritances, Franchiles and Postellions whatsoever, Spiritual or Temporal, foods of Chatteles, to the yearly amount or value of One honfand Pounds Sterling, to them the faid - and others ne Governors and Visitors of the said School, or the maor part of them, or Survivors of them Incorporate, and their uccellors for Even, to and for the Uses of the School afores aid; and the faid Governors and Visitors, and the longIf Liver and Successors of them, be, and are hereby declared, the true, fole and undoubted Rector, Governors and Vifitors of he faid School in aforelaid; with full and absolute ower, Liberty ard Authority, in making and ordaining fuch aws, Orders and Rules, for the good Government of the faid.
School. as to them the faid Rector; Governors and fisitor: or the major, partiof them, orisheir Successors, chall rom Time to Time, as occasion may kequire, seem meet, ne-ellary and becoming, all synich shall be observed by the Mas-irs, Uthers, and Scholars, of the, said —— School, upon e Penalties therein contained: Provided, That such Rules;

Orders, and Laws, be no way contrary to the King Prerogative, the Rights of the Lord Proprietary, of this Province, or the Laws, Statutes, or Usage of the Kingdom of Great Britain, or of this Province, or the Canons and Conflictions of the Church of England, as by Law established. And for the perpetuating the Succession of the faid Rector, Governor, and Vintors.:

Be it Enaded, That after the Expiration of Twelve Months, to commence from the End of this Sellion of Affembly, or up on the Death or Removal of him the faid ...
