

For Masters of Every such Ship or Vessel respectively in
which any such Tolls shall be levied on or about
the twenty ninth day of Sept^r next During the
continuance of this Act upon their arrival
or taking out his or their dispatches for every
such respective Ship or Vessel and before the Departure
of such Ship or Vessel and the Master or Masters of Every
such Ship or Vessel coming into this Province shall
at their first arrival here and before their loading
on board any goods or commodities of the growth or produ-
ction or Manufacture of this Province give good &
Sufficient Security for the payment thereof as is herein
before directed and the said Naval Officers on the re-
ceipt of the eighteen pence per Tonn shall be &
are hereby obliged to render an account of and pay
the same to the publick Treasurer of this Province
after the same manner that they are required to
account and pay the duties raised to defray the publick
Charge of this Province to be by such Treasurer ac-
counted for and paid to the right Hon^{ble} Benedict
Leonard Lord Ballenore Proprietor of this Province
in case he shall be favourably pleased to accept the
same ^{in consideration} of his receiving his Quit rents
and Alienation fines during the continuance
of this Act in Tolls at the rate of two pence for
pound after fully Assessed by his said Lordship
