The half quarters and other parts, in proportion to their Denomination, and light pieces in proportion to their Weight; and the currency of all other Silver Coyns of the same or baser Alloy, shall, after the said first Day of May, stand Regulated according to their Weight and Fineness, according and in proportion to the Rate, before limited and set for Pieces of Eight of *Sevil*, *Pillar* and *Mexico*.

At a Sessions of Assembly begun and held at the City of *Annapolis*, *October* the Twenty third, and ended *November* the Third, in the Tenth Year of the Reign of our most Gracious Sovereign Lady *Anne*, of *Great Britain*, *France* and *Ireland*, Queen, Defender of the Faith, &c. *Annoq; Domini* 1711. were Enacted these Laws following, *viz.*

An Act to Empower Commissioners to appoint and Cause to be laid out three Thousand Acres of Land on *Broad-Creek* in *Somerset* County, for the use of the *Nanticoke* Indians; so long as they shall occupy the same.

**W**HEREAS it is Represented to this present General Assembly that the Land formerly laid out for the use of the *Nanticoke* Indians, is now much worn out, and not sufficient for them; and that it is thought advisable that some further Provision be made for them.
