

The Titles of the Acts of Maryland.

Part of an Act, Intituled,

N^o 5. *A Supplementary Act to the Act, directing the Manner of Electing and Summoning Delegates and Representatives to serve in succeeding Assemblies, &c.*
Electors of Assembly-men to take the Oaths.

N^o 6. *An Act for confirming Titles of Land given to the Uses of the Churches and several Chappels within this Province, empowering the Commissioners of the respective Counties, and the Vestries of the respective Parishes, to take up certain Parcels of Land for the Use of the same.*
Confirming Titles of Lands given to Churches and Chappels.

N^o 7. *An Act to declare how the Forty Pounds of Tobacco per Poll, in such Parishes where there is no Incumbent, shall be disposed of.*
Disposal of the Forty Pounds of Tobacco per Poll.

N^o 8. *An Act empowering the Commissioners of the County Courts to levy and raise Tobacco, to defray the necessary Charges of their Counties and Parishes.*

N^o 9. *An Act for Erecting Ann-Arundel and Oxford Towns into Ports and Towns.*
Land for a Church or Chapel.

N^o 10. *An Act for uniting Newport Hundred, now Part of King and Queen's Parish, to William and Mary Parish in Charles County.*
Newport Hundred united to William and Mary Parish.

N^o 11. *An Act for Erecting a Parish on the North Side of Elk River, in Cecil County.*
Parish on the North Side of Elk River.

N^o 12. *An Act empowering the Justices of the seven County Courts within this Province, to regulate the Bounds*
Bounds of Parishes.
