

not sell, give or dispose of any strong or spirituous Liquor, or give any Entertainment or other Accommodations, upon any pretence whatsoever, to any Servant, Negro or other Slave, under pain of losing the Price of Liquor so sold, given or disposed of, and paying moreover the Sum of *Twenty Shillings* current Money to be recovered before any single Magistrate of the County, upon the Oath or Affirmation if a Quaker, of any one credible Witness and applied as aforesaid.

SUCH Ordinary Keeper, shall not sell, give or dispose, of any Liquors or other Accommodations, or give any Entertainment in any Booth or other Conveniency, except such as shall be at his or her Dwelling House, to any Person or Persons whatsoever, on any of the several and respective Days on which such Meetings shall be kept and held as aforesaid, after Sun setting of the same Day, under the Penalty and Forfeiture of *Five Pounds* current Money, for every such Offence, to be recovered and applied as aforesaid.

No Person or Persons whatsoever, shall hereafter run or pace any Race or Races, with any Horse, Mare or Gelding, for any Wager or Wagers, for Diversion or any Pretence whatsoever, on the Ground commonly called New Market, in *Talbot* County, or within the Distance of Five Miles from the Meeting-House in the said County, or within Five Miles of the Meeting-House on *West River*, in *Ann Arundel* Connty, on the Days on which the said Meetings or either of them shall be kept and held, under the Penalty of the Owner or Owners of such Horse, Mare or Gelding, who shall so run or pace his Horse, Mare or Gelding, or knowingly suffer them to be run or paced, forfeiting and paying for every such Race *Five Pounds* current Money to be recovered and applied as aforesaid. And the Person or Persons who shall presume to make any Horse-Race, lay any Wager on such Race, or run for his or their Diversion, or who shall presume to ride a Race on any Horse, Mare or Gelding belonging to any other Person, on the Days and within the Distances from the said respective Meeting-Houses afore mentioned, shall for every Offence, forfeit and pay the Sum of *Five Pounds* current Money to be recovered and applied as aforesaid.

THE Constables of the several and respective Hundreds of the said Counties of *Ann Arundel* and *Talbot*, shall upon their knowing or being applied to, during the Time of the Holding of the said yearly Meetings, by any other Person or Persons informing them, that great Numbers or Crowds of Negro's or other Slaves have met in a tumultuous and disorderly Manner within the said Counties, immediately to repair with such Assistance, as he or they shall think necessary, to such Place, where such Negro's or other Slaves shall be assembled, and require and command them immediately to disperse, and retire to their several Dwellings; which if they or any of them, shall refuse or delay to do, or shall behave impudently and turbulently, such Constable or Constables shall seize and take such Negro or Negro's or other Slave or Slaves so refusing, delaying or misbehaving, and give him, her or them
