N. B. In Nuncupative Wills the following Regulations must be observed. No Nuncupative Will is good when exceeding £ 30 Sterling, if not proved by Three Witnesses present at the making thereof, it must be proved that the Testator bid them bear Witness, must be made in his last Sickness.

Must be proved in Six Months after made, thereafter no Testimony can be received, except the Testimony or Substance thereof, were committed to Writing, within Six Days after the making thereof as above.

It cannot be proved till Fourteen Days after the Testators Death, and the Widow and nearest in Kin must be called.

No Will in Writing can be altered thereby, Stat. 29. C. 2. & 3.
