

proprietary, and before due and public Notice or Proclamation thereof given and made, in the respective Counties within this Province, by such Person or Persons as shall be properly and legally authorized and appointed thereto, shall be good, effectual, and available in Law, to all Intents, Constructions, and Purposes whatsoever; the Death or Demise of such Proprietary notwithstanding.

And be it further Enacted, That from henceforth the Commission, Power or Authority of the Lieutenant Governor, or Commander in Chief of this Province for the Time being, shall not be determined or dissolved, by the Death or Demise of the Right Honourable the Proprietary that now is, or any of his Heirs or Successors, having legal Right to the Government of the said Province; but that such Lieutenant Governor or Commander in Chief shall continue and act as such, untill he shall be lawfully removed or discharged, or his Commission superseded or determined by the next Successor. And that hereafter all Judges, Justices, Magistrates, Ministers of Justices, and all and every Person and Persons in any of the Offices, Places, and Employments within this Province, shall continue and act in their respective Offices, Places, and Employments, according to their respective Functions, Duties, and Stations, notwithstanding the Death or Demise of the Right Honourable the Lord Proprietary that now is, his Heirs or Successors, until they shall be lawfully removed or discharged, or their respective Commissions superseded or determined by the next Successor, or the Lieutenant Governor or Commander in Chief, for the Time being; any Law, Usage, or Custom, to the contrary notwithstanding.
