

tion of all tracts or parts of tracts, lines and bound-
at he may be charged with in capacity of a commis-
sioner to the true original location thereof, according
to the survey which shall be offered or appear to him, without
reference to the best of his experience and judgment
recorded among the records of the said county.

A majority of said commissioners may constitute a board,
and they may adjourn from time to time, but no location
shall be made or fixed without the concurring opinion and signature

of a majority of them should appear to the satisfaction of the court that the
commissioners are in any manner interested in the matter
before them, or should be in difference or controversy with any
person, or should be in any way disqualified, the court
may, at any time, and on any application whatever, such commissioner or commissioners
before the court shall appoint another or others in their place,
and the person so appointed shall qualify as aforesaid before he acts as such commissioner.

Each commissioner shall be entitled to receive
for his services he shall attend in discharge of his duty, including the
time he spends from and to his home, and that any person acting as
surveyor shall receive such per diem allowance as the commissioner
may determine. For each day such surveyor shall be summoned
to attend shall receive for each day he shall be travelling
from and to his home, and that each chainman shall receive
for the time he may be employed; and in all cases the court
shall ascertain and give orders therefor on the person
to whom the service was performed, the payment of which shall be
made by the court issuing the commission, in the same manner as
for attendance; and it shall be the duty of the commissioner
to attend in the execution of any warrant or order whatever
issued by the court on such warrant or order.

Commissioners appointed and qualified as before directed shall be
of good behaviour, removable by such court for any cause
shown. No commissioner shall be allowed to take up and sell
any land, or cause it to be done for his use or benefit, during
