

8th section, and the same was amended by striking out the words "any clerk of a county," in the second line thereof, in the manuscript, and inserting in lieu thereof, "the clerk or register of any."

On motion by Mr. Peach, the following proviso, which he offered, was then adopted, and added at the end of the 8th section, viz.

"Provided, That the provisions of this section shall not be taken or construed so as to prevent attorneys in any of the aforesaid courts from having their appearances entered in cases where they bring the cause of action to the clerks of said courts, to have suits docketed: And provided further, that the provisions of this section shall not be so taken or construed as to affect the power of the judges of the aforesaid courts, to assign counsel to parties at bar."

On motion by Mr. Peach, the 9th section was also reconsidered and amended, by striking out after "clerk," in the first line thereof, the words "of a county court," and inserting "or register as aforesaid."

The question was then propounded, Shall this bill pass as amended?
