

An act to regulate sales by public auction; severally endorsed "will not pass."

Also communicating bills originated in and passed by the senate, entitled, An act to incorporate the Maryland Chymical Works. And an act relating to mortgages, in the city and county of Baltimore; which were severally read and referred; the former to Messrs. Stricker, Buchanan and Done, and the latter to Messrs. Buchanan, Tyson and Goldsborough.

And the following message, which was read:

On motion by Mr. Goldsborough, seconded by two other members who voted in the majority on the question, the house agreed to reconsider their decision of to day, rejecting the bill, entitled, An act to authorise Eliakim Little to institute, carry on and draw a lottery, the prizes in which shall consist of works in literature and science.

Mr. Tidball asked for and obtained leave of the house to withdraw from its further consideration the bill, reported by him, entitled, An act to abolish the high court of chan-
