An act to repeal all that part of the constitution and form of government, as relates to the division of Dorchester county into six separate election districts.

A supplement to the act, entitled, An act to establish a patrol in Calvert county, passed at December session 1822, chapter 85.

An act to divorce Theodore Kimmel, and Elizabeth Kimmel his wife, of the city of Baltimore. And,

An act for the benefit of James Wolfenden, and Joseph Jamison, of Baltimore county. Severally endorsed "will pass."

Also, An act relating to certain property of Rebecca Smith, of Baltimore county, endorsed "will pass with the proposed amendment," which amendment was twice read by a special order and assented to.

Also a resolution in favour of Robert Ross, of Allegany county.

A resolution in favour of Mary Moore, of Dorchester county.

A resolution relative to Belle Air Academy, in Harford county.

A resolution in favour of Walter Pruitt, of Worcester county.

A resolution in favour of Sarah Smith, of the city of Baltimore.

A resolution in favour of Sarah M. Kinsey, of Allegany county.

A resolution in favour of Elizabeth Heaton, of Berk's county, Pennsylvania.

A resolution in favour of Ann Hollydyoak, of the city of Annapolis. And,

A resolution extending to Robert Stewart, collector of Somerset county, further time to complete his collections; severally endorsed "assented to." Whereupon, it was Ordered, that the said bills and resolutions be severally engrossed.

Also, An act to establish pilots, and regulate their fees.

An act directing the manner of settling disputes relative to officers fees, and for other purposes.

An act to regulate the entering or recording satisfaction of any judgment or decree entered or rendered in any court of this state.

An act relative to certain trespasses, in Montgomery county; severally endorsed "will not pass."
