

ANNAPOLIS, MD (Maryland Republican)

The Maryland Republican was published from June 17, 1809 until November 5, 1908 when it merged with the Anne Arundel Advertiser to form the Advertiser-Republican.

Title Varies: Maryland Republican, June 17, 1809-July 10, 1817; Maryland Republican or Political and Agricultural Museum, July 17, 1817-August 22, 1826; Maryland Republican, August 26, 1826-March 14, 1868; Maryland Republican and State Capitol Advertiser, March 21, 1868-1882; Maryland Republican, 1882-June 13, 1886; Maryland Republican and State Journal, June 20, 1886- .

Publication Frequency: weekly, semi-weekly during sessions of the legislature, June 17, 1809-1847; weekly, 1851-1908.

Issues of the Maryland Republican are from the collections of the Maryland Hall of Records, the Maryland Historical Society, and the Library of Congress.
