

3 - That Notwithstanding any Reservation made by his Lopp, or his Loppes Surveyor gen^{le} for his Loppes use of any lands on either side of Mount Scarborough in the County of Somersett within y^e said Province you shall forthwith make good all Articles made by our deare Brother Giles Calvert Esq on his Loppes behalfe and Colonel Edmund Scarborough upon the laying out of the bounds betweene his Loppes said Province and the Province of Virginia in relation to the granting of any the Lands in and by the said Articles agreed to be granted to any person or persons what soever at the time of the making of the said Articles so as the said grants be made according to his Loppes conditions of Plantation before his Loppes Instructions above mentioned bearing date the 28th of July 1669, and so as all Royall mines be excepted in every such grant -

4 - Whereas his Lopp is informed that his seale for Ann Arundell County hath been put, and is now in the keeping of Mr Thomas Fuller his Loppes will and pleasure is that the said seale be forthwith taken from him, and put into the hands of Mr Samuel Chew one of his Loppes Councell, and Inhabitant of the said County of Ann Arundell, and in these respects most properly qualified for having the Custody of the same Wherefore you are not to faile in the speedy performance of his Loppes will and pleasure hereon, Given under his Loppes hand and lesser seale at Armes this one and twentieth day of March 1669²⁰ -
