

And is ordered to make good and continue the said payment to him, until he shall have some place or Employment in the Province, which I hope he already has or will shortly obtain or until my further Orders be signified to you —

11 In case of the Death of you the said Nicholas Lowe, I do hereby authorize, and empower Col^l Matthew Ward to do and execute all the powers granted you by our Commission bearing even Date with these presents he observing the Orders and Instructions we now have, or hereafter shall send either to you or him, first giving Security to my Lieutenant Governor for the time being for the due Execution thereof —

12 And Lastly whatever is not herein Directed and Expressly Mentioned which is in any of your Late Brothers Instructions you are to conform yourself thereto as Occasion may Offer. And you are to acquaint our Lieutenant Governor with our Commission to you which must be Recorded with these our Instructions and in all things hold a fair Correspondence with him as shall be thought Necessary for our Service —
