And I will and require You to give proper Directions at any time to my Agent and Receiver general, to aid and assist for conducting any such Foreigners who shall come to settle in our said Province, as to the Expence thereof to my account on easy and moderate Terms, which may be necessary for their service in going to the Places they shall settle in.
