

That your Petitioner by patent as aforesaid bearing date the said 25th day of March 1676 hath also Granted unto him a certain parcell of Land lying and being on the back Side of the Town of New castle on Delaware River according to the Bounds mentioned in the said patent except what is therein excepted containing and laid out for One hundred Acres

That John Astin deceased by patent as aforesaid bearing date the first day of October 1669 had Granted unto him a House Garden and Land thereunto belonging at New Castle in Delaware River Bounded according to the said patent and containing Six Acres four Lots whereof Jonas Astin Son and Heir of the said John Astin sold and made over unto Johannes de Hayes and Ephraim Herman Executors of Martin Roosmond deceased and the Remainder of the said Land and premises, was by the said Jonas Astin and Jane his Mother Widow and Relict of the said deceased John Astin for a valuable Consideration, sold assigned and made over to your Petitioner and is now in his possession as may be made appear

That your Petitioner by patent as aforesaid bearing date the 17 day of November 1679 had Granted to him three several Lots of Ground in the aforesaid Town of New Castle formerly belonging to Captain John Carr Butting and Bounding as in the said patent is set forth and may appear &c. &c. by patent as aforesaid bearing date 25th day of March 1676 had Granted to him one other Lot of Ground in New Castle aforesaid being the place where the Magarine House stood according to the Metes and Bounds in the said patent mentioned

That William Tomlin by Patent as aforesaid bearing date the 25 day of July 1669 had Granted unto him a certain House and Lot at New Castle aforesaid formerly belonging to Peter Alricks, as also half a Lot of Ground in the said Town where formerly the Mill stood, Butting and Bounding as in the said patent is expressly set forth, which House and half a Lot next to Peter Alricks now dwelling House was by the said William Tomlin assigned and set over to Martin Roosmond who also sold the same to John Edmondson and John Edmondson to your Petitioner in whose Possession the same and each and every the aforementioned Tracts or Parcels or Lots of Land now is and are in manner aforesaid
