The honorable C^o Henry Darnall informs the Board that besides his
D^{ty} General Letters to his Council, he had rec^d particular and
Special Commands from his Lord to take all Effectual Care imaginable
for the Security and safe Guard of the frontiers and heads of the Rivers
from any Foreigne Invasions or Incroachments to be made upon any
part of his Lord's Land and more especially had Reason to doubt
the Maintenance of the fort at Christina Bridge wherefore he pray^d
the Consideration and Order of this Board what sh^d and necessary
be done therein

It is Considered and Resolved
By this Board that George Spivey from hence requiring of
M^{ty} to continue his Land in the Guard and Maintenance of
Station at Christina fort and that Maj^r Edw^d Juglish for Cecil County
Maj^r Peter Sayer for Talbot County C^o George Wells for Baltimore
County and C^o Tom Stevens for Somerset and Dorchester Counties be
Strictly required to take Especial Care for the defence maintenance and
Preservation of the heads of the Rivers and frontier parts within their
Respective County's precincts and Commands from any Incroachments
