other Nations, you are then to cause him to be forthwith conveyed down to us
our Council at our City of St. Marie, for Examination and further proceeding
in a case shall think fittest

9 And to the End Due Record may be kept of all your proceedings & Transactions
in Matters of Land according to the foregoing Instructions, you are to keep an exact
Register of all Warrants by you issued, Copies whereof together with Certificates of
Survey thereupon made you are from time to time, and at all Times hereafter when
and as often as conveniently you can to transmit under your hand unto our Secretarys
office at our City of St. Marie, there to be entered upon Record.

10 And whatsoever shall by you given be acted and done pursuant and con-
sonant to these our Instructions shall well be good firm & valid to all intents
and Purposes, hereby Ratifying approving and confirming to of same to be
Given under our hand & seal at Arnhem the Twelfth day of March in the

CHARLES & C. To George Talbot Esq. Greeting out of our special trust reposed
in your Fidelity, conduct, courage and circumspection, and in your Affection to us
and to the good and Lawfull Interest we have thought fit to constitute and do
by Commission Ordaine & Appoint you to be our Commissioner for disposal of Lands
in New Ireland and the adjacent parts adjoining to the River and Bay of the said Province
side thereof and to the Northward of the fortieth degree of Northern Latitude there to grant
Warrant in our Name for Lands not actually Inhabited, nor already layd out in
our Name for other of ours, to all of ours desiring of same, according to the Tenour
of Instructions already delivered to you, and likewise to protect and defend
your utmost power, of Persons & Estates of all People in those parts who shall put
themselves willingly under the Protection of our Government. According to your Instruc-
tions aforesaid to use you are (in Cases of urgent necessity) to use the use of Assis-
tance of such a part of your Regiment of horse as you shall thin necessary you are
also to read Article in our Name which persons living in those parts, as shall
willingly submit themselves to our Government and what you promise them under
hand & seal as to Confirmation of our Right to their Lands in the parts aforesaid
we do hereby bind our self to see performed, as also that they shall be defended and
protected in their Estates and persons from all others. Concerning to their Lands or
Wells we also hereby constitute and Appoint you of said George Talbot Deputy for
of North & North East Counties of this our Province, hereby authorizing and requir-
ing you to use the utmost of your Skill Industry and power to prevent and
hinder by Inroad into of the said East Govern^r and Proprietor of Pennsylvania
his Partakers on of Counties and borders aforesaid to which you are required to observe
of Instructions formerly given you dated the 21st Instant, and your latter Instructions be-
ing equal date herewith in building and Peopling of houses and Seating Plantations
at our Charge in convenient vacant places near, Counties, and more particularly
in one place mentioned in of said Instructions and of said house, we will to be
preserve and defend to our use to of almost of your Industry and power. We do
require and Authorise you to Appoint by Warrant under your Great Seal as
many Rangers and foresters in of Counties afo as you shall thin necessary for
killing and taking up to our Use all wilde unmarket Cattle
and Swine allowing of said Rangers and foresters such a part of of said Wells
