

them at his pleasure. And to doe all and every thing whiche unto the charge and office of a
 Capitayn Generall of an Army or Admirall of a fleet belongeth. And likewise in case of
 any Rebellion Tumult or Sedition, either upon the Land within our said Province and Dominion
 or upon the Sea to Exercise, Martiell Lawes against all rebellious Mutinuous or factious persons
 of those parts who shall refuse to submit themselves to our Governour or to serve in the wars
 or shall fly to the enemy or forsake their Ensignes, or be captured or straggled or otherwise
 howsoever offending against the Law Customs or Discipline Military as fully and in as ample
 manner and forme as any Capitayn Generall of an Army or Admirall of a Navy by virtue
 of his Office might or hath been accustomed to use the same. And further we doe give and graunt
 unto our said Governour full power and authority during the time of his Continuance in the said
 Office or so long mentioned for us and in our name as often as he shall thinke fitting from
 time to time to pardon remit or release whether before judgement or after all and all
 manner of Criminall offences against the Lawes of our said Province and Dominion or any
 of them and also all and all manner of penalties and forfeitures incurred or to be
 incurred by any person or persons bodies politicke or private within our said Province
 Dominion or any of them for or by reason of any Crime or Crimes offences or Offences
 Committed or to be committed against any the Lawes Ordinances or orders of our said Province
 heretofore made or hereafter to be made whatsoever or howsoever as fully and amply
 to all intents Instructions and purposes as we our self might doe if we were there
 and then personally present to doe the same, as also for us and in our name and as
 often as he shall thinke it necessary from time to time to call a generall and summon an
 generall Assembly or generall Synod of the free men of our said Province or of their
 Deputies or Delegates for the giving of the Advice assent and approbation of the
 Statutes of our said Province to such Lawes and Acts as shall by us at any time
 be made and enacted and under our Seale published, and unto whiche the Advice
 assent and approbation of the free men of our said Province shall at any time require
 and necessary and the said generall Assembly and Synod so from time to time
 called assembled and summoned or to be called assembled or summoned from time to
 time when and as often as he shall thinke it necessary in our name to procure
 or otherwise to doe at his pleasure, and likewise for us and in our name and
 our absence from our said Province to ordaine make and enact by and with the Advice
 assent and approbation of any such Assembly or Synod so called assembled or
 summoned as aforesaid to be of force until we our self or our heirs and assigns
 Lords and Proprietaries of the said Province shall declare and publish or cause to
 be declared and published within our said Province or his Part or some of their
 particular District or Districts, Disagreement or Disagreements to the same under or
 his their or some of their Seales or Seales so as the said Lawes and Acts so to be ordaine
 made and enacted be consonant to Reason and be not Repugnant or contrary but
 rather as conveniently may be agreeable to the Lawes Statutes and Customs of the
 Kingdom of England, and so as the same be no wayes Repugnant unto our
 of our Rights privileges or Jurisdiction, or to the Disinheritance of us our heirs
 assigns Lords and Proprietaries of the said Province or contrary to our or
 power government or Dominion, or Contradictory to a certain Act of Assembly
 heretofore made in the nineteenth year of our Dominion James Our thought
 his undoubted and fully published an Act concerning Religion. and likewise we doe
 further give and graunt unto our said Governour during the time of his Continuance
 of the said Office of our said full power and authority from time to time to make
 constitute ordaine and publish in our name such whole or in part Reasonable and profitable
 Ordinances
