Exercised at our full might lawfully do if we were personally present
also full power and authority to direct and appoint for us and in our name to pass
under our Great Seal of our said Province, full Grants and Grants of full proportion
proportion of lands within our said Province to full persons and persons and full Grants
and Estates and with full privileges and Immunities and under such Conditions as we
have directed or shall from time to time hereafter direct by any warrant or warrants
under our Great Seal at London, so at the said warrant and warrants to be duly taken
and Registered and the said lands duly Surveyed, and the Surveyors thereof Returned and
all and every the necessary Rules Orders Circumstances hereof by us given or
appointed in Relation to the Surveying of such lands and to the entering Registering and
attesting the Surveyors Returns, and all necessary Circumstances touching full Grants
Surveyors and warrants hereof by us given or appointed to be first duly offered and
performed, willing and by these presents requiring our said Deans to advise at
their shall be occasion with those who are or shall be of our Council that for the
time bring upon all Emergent occasions, touching concerning or relating unto the
good Government of our said Province, and of the people therein. And we do hereby
Revoke annul and make void all former Commissions hereof at any time
given unto our said Deans or any others in Relation to all or any the
offices powers or authorities hereby granted, and all and every Power and
Power authority and authority thing and thing in them every or any of the
given granted mentioned or contained hereby declaring the same to be revoked
annulled and made void to all intents and purposes immediately from and after
the publishing of these presents within our said Province. Given under our Hand and
Seal at London the thirteenth day of February in the fourth and thirtieth year
of our Dominion over our said Province Annoque Domini 1665.
