 we will that our said Chancelour or our said Principall Secretary shalbe one) shall in our
 absence together with our yt Governall and Chief Governour for the time being of our said
 Province or his sufficient Deputy or Deputyes by him to be assigned be a full sufficient
 complete Councill, for the ends and purposes aforesaid, Willing and by these presents
 requiring and firmly injoyning all persons of our said Province and Dominion aforesaid
 that in all things relating to the premises they give obedience unto our said Councill
 and to all such orders and Comands as shall from time to time be made and given by our
 said Councill or any two or more of them (of which our said Chancelour and Principall
 Secretary or out of them to be one) by and with the consent and approbation of us or
 of our Governant Governall and Chief Comander of our said Province for the time
 being, or of his lawfull & sufficient Deputy or Deputyes by him to be assigned be as such
 orders and Comands be consonant to Reason and be not repugnant or contrary to
 Lawe of our said Province, nor repugnant or contrary unto but at leaste at our said
 may be agreeable to and with the Lawes Statutes and Customs of the Kingdome of England
 And we doe hereby revoke revoke annulle and make void all and every former and
 other Comission and Comissions, Letters patents orders and authorities whatsoever
 by us at any time heretofore formerly given for the erecting creating constituting or
 appointing of a privy Councill within our said Province or the Dominion thereto belonging
 or for the erecting or appointing any person or persons to be of our private secret
 continuall Councill then or to be of the private secret or continuall Councill to any
 our Governant or Governants his or their Deputy or Deputyes of or in our said
 Province, or any the Dominion or Territory thereto belonging. Witness our self at
 the fiftenth day of February in the fourth thirtieth year of our Dominion over our
 Province of Maryland. And in the year of our Lord God One thousand six hundred
 sixty five this witness.

 Justice and Equity may be duly and impartially administered to all and every person and
 persons bodies politic and Corporations and within our Province of Maryland aforesaid
 we have constituted assigned and appointed, and doe hereby constitute assigne and appointe
 our most dear Sonne Charles Calvert Esquire our Governall Chief Capitaine Chief Admirall
 Chief Governour and Chief Comander of our said Province of Maryland and of all our
 Dominion and Territory thereto belonging to be our Chief Justice of our Provinciaall
 Court of our said Province during our pleasure, aswell for the holding of all pleas
 touching and relating unto the Conservation of us, and the Conservation of the
 peace of our said Province as for the holding of pleas touching our Rights and
 Honour and of Common Pleas and likewise for the Determining of all matters
 of equity for which any Relief is shall or may be justly or reasonably desired in
 said Court And whereas we have likewise constituted assigned and appointed and doe
 by these presents constitute assigne and appointe our Dear Brother and Councellor
